EWEA 2014 will take place at Fira de Barcelona Gran Via in Barcelona in Spain. The event venue is situated only a short distance from both Barcelona's El Prat International Airport (7 km) and the city centre (2.5km), making it an ideal location for international and domestic business.

From the Airport

By Taxi 21km / 15 minutes travel time.
By Metro – 1.3km from the North Entrance.

By Taxi

There is a large taxi rank service directly outside the airport. The price to the convention is around €20.00 (there is a minimum charge of €20.00 for taxis from the airport) plus a small supplement for each suitcase that you have. Travel time approximately 15 minutes.

You will find a taxi rank outside any of the main terminal exits Terminal 1 (T1) or Terminal 2 (and of the 3 buildings of Terminal 2 - T2A, T2B or T2C). Look for the sign pointing to the nearest taxi rank.

Access

All exhibitors and contractors must wear a contractor wristband at all times during the build-up and breakdown of the exhibition. Contractor wristbands should be collected from the security personnel upon arrival on site.

Access and deliveries can arrive on all sides of the hall, once vehicles have registered with traffic marshals they will be directed to the nearest vehicle access door.

Once your vehicle has been unloaded / loaded please leave site as soon as possible. There is a lorry park near the venue. Please see Lorry Access below.

In order to provide a smooth flow of traffic during set-up and dismantling periods and during the event, the traffic regulations below must be observed at all times.

Within exhibition halls and elsewhere traffic conditions demand, drivers shall drive at walking speed. Drivers shall come to a full stop at the entrances to, and exits from exhibition halls and shall verify that gate heights are adequate.

- Vehicle access to the halls for unloading and loading must be agreed with the EWEA Operations Team and Venue Traffic Marshals.
- Vehicles' engines shall be shut off during loading/unloading.
- Caravans/ campers may not be used on the exhibition grounds.
- Illegally parked vehicles, trailers, containers, and goods of any kind may be removed by authorised towing companies working under contract to Fira de Barcelona at their owners' or operators' expense and risk.
- All traffic should be removed from the venue site before 21.45hrs daily.
- The instructions of personnel assigned by Fira de Barcelona to direct and supervise traffic and the associated information shall be followed at all times.

Venue technical information



Please keep in mind strict venue regulations related to stand construction and structural approval fee, for complex stands exceeding 4m and platforms 50cm and over.

Hall 6 & 7

All mains for power, spotlights, network and telephone cabling, as well as plumbing will be run into your stand via service ducts in the hall floor. Maximum load-bearing capacity is **5000kg/ m²**.

- ❖ Maximum build height, including banners and rigging is 6m, maximum height for lighting rig (only) is 8m.
- ❖ There are 0.60m concrete pillars in the hall. Some pillars include Fire Hose and cabinet; these must not be obstructed when considering your stand designs. Please refer to the technical plan of the hall to see if the pillars are next to your stand.

Service ducts

Whenever a service duct is shared between more than one stand in one island, it must remain accessible at all times (through a hatch). In order to have a hatch, we recommend a platform of 50mm for electrical cables only, and 100mm if a water connection is planned for any of the neighbouring stands.

If during build up or show any cable gets unplugged for some reason, the duct needs to be accessed by the technical teams. Whenever a service duct is half covered by a division wall or is at the limit of the stand, the area around the duct must remain accessible

Carpet in the aisles

Aisle carpet will be run as a strip down the centre of the aisle and not edge to edge with your stand. Please ensure that your carpet or platform edge is carefully finished.
