

## EWEC 2009 - A key event at a critical time

European Wind Energy Conference 2009 – 16-19 March, Marseille, France.

The European Wind Energy Conference (EWEC) 2009 comes at a critical time. Organised by the European Wind Energy Association (EWEA), it will be the sector's first large-scale discussion of the historic Renewable Energy Directive, newly agreed by the EU in December 2008. It will also be the industry's first major event since the financial crisis started shaking economies worldwide. From 16-19 March, EWEC delegates will meet in Marseille, France, to discuss and debate the new energy and economic era.

#### On 16 March, the opening day, two main press events will take place.
