I. Introduction

This is the Privacy Policy of the European Wind Energy Association ("EWEA") registered in Belgium under BE0476 915 445.

The official website for the EWEA, www.ewea.org, ("Site") is governed by laws and regulations of Belgium, including the Belgian Act of 8 December 1992 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.

We reserve the right to modify this Privacy Policy and will post the revised Privacy Policy on this Site, with a notice during x weeks on the homepage when such changes have been made.

II. Personal data

Your personal data are processed by EWEA asbl/vzw, Rue d'Arlon 80, B-1040 Brussels, in its capacity of data controller of your personal data.

Personal data include your name, address, phone number, e-mail address, credit or debit card account number, expiration date and security code and any other information that is associated with your personal data.

III. Purposes

We process your personal data for registration and handling purposes, *i.e.* for instance to complete an EWEA membership application, to register for an EWEA conference or seminar, to order a publication, to participate in an EWEA event or to pay for membership dues, EWEA events fees, publications, audio or video materials.

EWEA's selected partners may also use your contact details for direct marketing purposes, provided that you opt-in to receive such information when completing the registration form.

Subject to the above and except to the extent that communications of personal data to companies whose intervention as data processors, acting on behalf and under the sole control of EWEA, is required to accomplish the purposes indicated above, EWEA will not disclose, sell, rent or exchange such personal data to any other organization or entity, unless you are first notified and expressly agreed with it, or as otherwise required by law.

Since EWEA operates globally, you agree that your personal data may be transferred to locations outside the European Economic Area, including to countries that do not offer an adequate level of protection, such as the US. We will make all efforts to protect your personal data during such transfers including, where appropriate, the use of EC Model Clauses.

IV. Cookies and action tags

We also collect non-personal identifiable information passively using "cookies" and "action tags".

"Cookies" are small text files that are placed on your computer in order to identify your web browser and the activities of your computer on our Site and other websites. We may use Cookies, including tracking cookies, to allow us to statistically monitor how you are using our Site (e.g. which pages you find useful and which you do not) and to identify which pages are being used.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Although most browsers are initially set to accept cookies, you may



reset your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie or to reject cookies generally if you prefer. Most browsers offer instructions on how to do so in the "Help" section of the toolbar. While you are not required to accept our cookies to access our Site, if you reject cookies, certain offerings, features, or resources of our Site may not work properly and you may experience some loss of convenience.

"Action tags," also known as web beacons or gif tags, are a web technology used to help track website usage information, such as how many times a specific page has been viewed. Action tags are invisible to you, and any portion of our Site, including advertisements, or email sent on our behalf, may contain action tags. We may select and use from time to time different third parties to track website usage through action tags on our Site.

By using cookies and action tags together, we are able to gain valuable information to improve our Site and our online offerings and measure the effectiveness of our advertising and marketing campaigns by determining the popularity of certain content.

Finally, please note that advertisers and other third parties may also use their own cookies or action tags when you click on their advertisement or link to their website or service, on or from our Site.

This Privacy Policy does not govern the use of cookies or action tags by such third-party websites or providers of third-party advertising.

V. Security

EWEA is committed to protecting the security of your personal data. We use reasonable security technologies and procedures to protect your personal data from unauthorised access, use or disclosure.

VI. Access to and review of your personal data

We draw your attention to the fact that you have the right to access and restrict your personal data and, where appropriate, request rectification of any erroneous data relating to you. You may furthermore, at any moment, object by means of a simple request and free of charge, to the future processing of personal data relating to you for the purpose of direct marketing.
